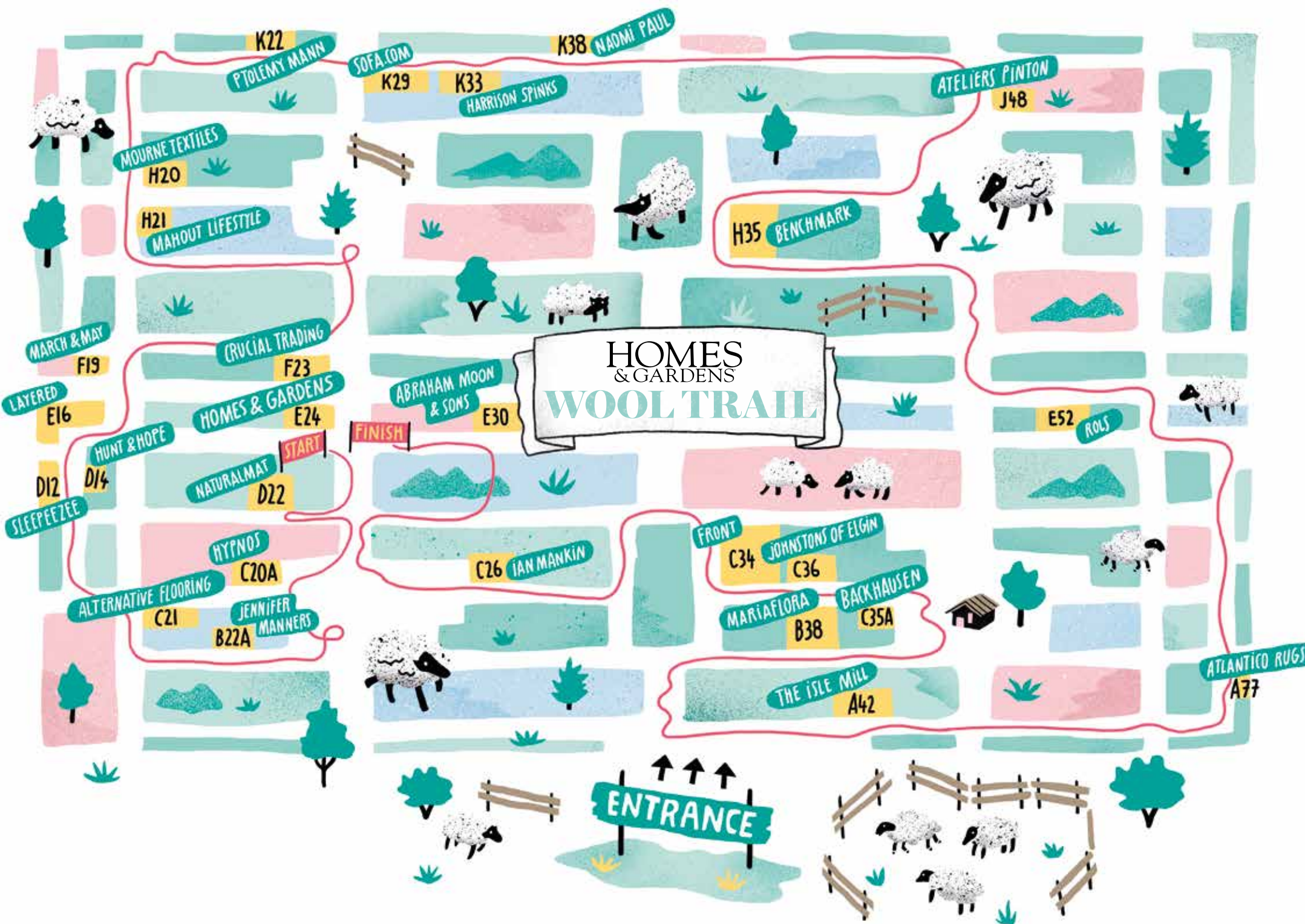

E30 ABRAHAM MOON & SONS Founded in 1837 with roots in apparel, this is one of the last remaining vertical woollen mills in Great Britain, with a reputation for consistent quality and innovative design. Come and discover more about the Abraham Moon mill, its illustrious company history, and the many natural benefits of wool fabrics.

C21 ALTERNATIVE FLOORING Discover fine and chunky wools in luxury plain and patterned designs from a brand passionate about putting the wool back into carpets. One highlight, Margo Selby Stripe, a collection of designer wool stripes for carpet, rugs and runners, beautifully crafted by woven textile designer Margo Selby.

J48 ATELIERS PINTON With 150 years at the forefront of the industry, the family owned Pinton mill is renowned for exceptional carpets, rugs and tapestries. Passion, combined with the expertise of its artisans, means the traditional art of Aubusson weaving is constantly being reinvented.

A77 ATLANTICO RUGS Atlantico is constantly designing and developing new patterns, while using the same Arraiolos long-armed cross-stitch method perfected by craftsmen and women in Portugal over 800 years ago. Working closely with all the major interior designers each rug is custom made with designs adapted and personalised to suit the individual client.

C35A BACKHAUSEN With a reputation for fabric excellence stretching back more than 160 years, new ownership of this traditional Austrian mill has seen the specialised industrial art of the 19th century translate into modern textile creations. With a back catalogue of more than 4,000 original designs, Backhausen collaborates frequently with contemporary artists to create a current collection that is full of individuality.

H35 BENCHMARK Known for making furniture with integrity, tactility and warmth, British furniture makers Benchmark is launching the Lyndal Sofa and Gleda range of chairs. Upholstered in 100% boiled wool and melange wool by British fabric company, Holland & Sherry, which have been chosen in neutral colours for a relaxed and cosy feel.

F23 CRUCIAL TRADING Crucial Trading has been designing, manufacturing and distributing the finest and most innovative floor coverings for over 30 years. With a great understanding and appreciation for the benefits of wool, it has developed over 40 unique patterns in a wide choice of colours, made using only the most luxurious and purest fibres.

C34 FRONT Front is the first handmade rug showroom in the UK to exclusively present the work of multi-award-winning rug designers Jan Kath, Zoë Luyendijk and Michaela Schleyppen. All challenge convention, developing new techniques and seeking the best creative solution in order to realise their design concepts and translate these into original floor art.

K33 HARRISON SPINKS A fifth generation family business specialising in luxury bed manufacture and supplier of quality components to the furniture industry. The journey starts at a 300 acre farm in Yorkshire, home to a flock of Texel, Suffolk, Zwartbles and Wensleydale sheep, reared in exchange for their quality pure-grade wool.

D14 HUNT & HOPE Hunt & Hope is all about needlepoint and needlepoint is only stitched in wool. The wools are sourced, spun and dyed here in the UK and are made from a blend of 100% British wool. The huge range can be mixed and blended making a colour spectrum of infinite possibilities.

C20A HYPNOS A long-established family business with an illustrious Royal history to be proud of. Designed and handmade in its Buckinghamshire workshops, its mattresses and beds can be slept on in the best homes, yachts, palaces and hotels all over the world.

C26 IAN MANKIN Continuing its ethos of using natural and organic fibres, Ashfield is Ian Mankin's first exciting venture into wool. Woven at its own mill in Lancashire, the collection features reversible jacquard woven designs in melange-dyed Shetland wools spun in Yorkshire, creating softer hues blending easily with the existing range.

B22A JENNIFER MANNERS DESIGN Bespoke design studio specialising in exquisite handmade rugs

designed in London and crafted in Nepal. The brand new Stone Collection brings the beauty of precious stones and minerals to soft and luxurious hand knotted rugs, which are crafted in Himalayan wool and bamboo silk.

C36 JOHNSTONS OF ELGIN MILL A family-owned Scottish business, with 220 years of tradition and expertise in textile manufacturing. It has collections of plain, semi-plain and patterned fabrics, as well as a range of beautiful throws and bed throws. Manufacturing takes place at its weaving mill in Elgin, using the finest lambswool and merino yarns.

E16 LAYERED A Swedish interior brand offering high quality rugs and furniture for modern and elegant homes all over the world. The carpets are hand-woven in 100% wool, which gives a durable rug with an elegant feel. In the collection there are three classic patterns in two different shades of gray.

H21 MAHOUT LIFESTYLE The leading UK source for Indian rugs and dhurries. Showcasing some fabulous new designs created in-house, as well as a collection of established geometrics. Specialising in bespoke designs, colours and sizes, for residential or commercial use, with a lead time of 8-10 weeks.
